Heat Illness & Injury Prevention Standards Board Approves Heat Illness Changes

- The Cal/OSHA Standards Board unanimously adopted Division of Occupational Safety and Health-recommended revisions to the state heat illness prevention standard. ... **This Standard Applies To All Outdoor Places Of Employment:** Agriculture, Construction, Landscaping Oil and Gas Extraction Transportation or Delivery of: agricultural products, construction material or other heavy materials, industrial or commercial except for employment that consists of operating an air-conditioned vehicle and does not include loading or unloading.

EPA Lead Safety Certification

- IN APRIL 2010, FEDERAL LAW REQUIRED CONTRACTORS THAT DISTURB LEAD-BASED PAINT IN HOMES, CHILD CARE FACILITIES AND SCHOOLS, BUILT BEFORE 1978 TO BE CERTIFIED AND FOLLOW SPECIFIC WORK PRACTICES TO PREVENT LEAD CONTAMINATION. **Who Needs This Certification?** Currently certified Lead Abatement Supervisors and Workers, Individuals that perform renovation activities, Firms that perform renovation activities.

Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD) and Practitioner (QSP)

- The California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has now implemented training requirements related to the new General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction and Land Disturbance Activities. By September 2, 2011, individuals developing and revising SWPPPs must obtain certification as a Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD), while individuals implementing best management practices and/or conducting site monitoring, sampling, and reporting activities must obtain certification as a Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP).

The first step in becoming a certified QSP and/or QSD is to take a CASQA-approved training course. The SBETC has training courses available to meet these requirements.
